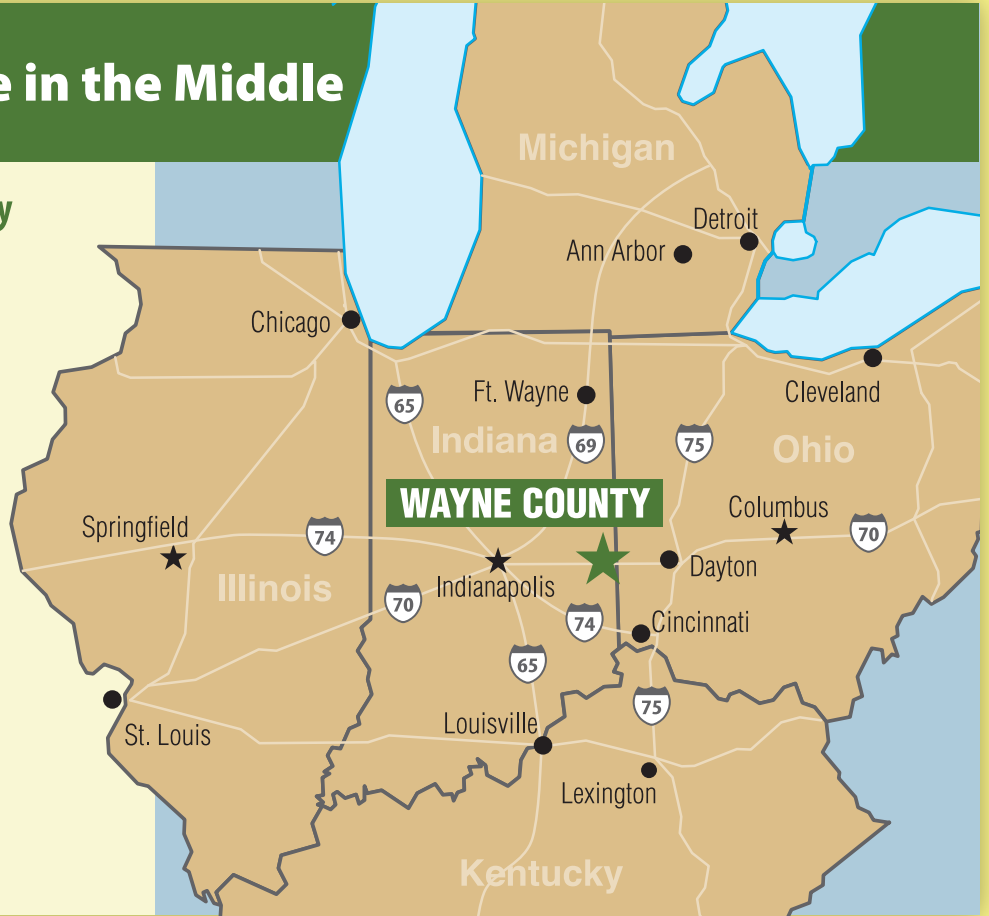


# We've Got it Made in the Middle

- Louisville.....170 miles



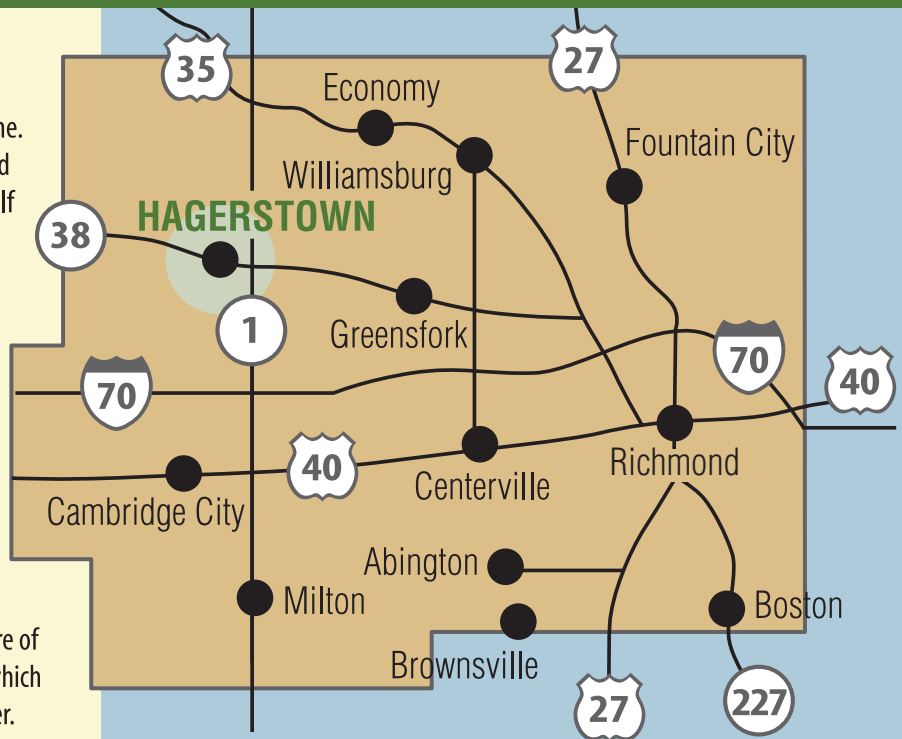
# The County Up Close

## Wayne County trivia:

The county was named for General Anthony Wayne. Known as "Mad Anthony" for his quick temper and battlefield brashness, Wayne distinguished himself in the Revolutionary War and went on to defeat the Iroquois in the Battle of Fallen Timbers near present-day Toledo, Ohio.

The town of Hagerstown was founded in 1832. The Whitewater canal ran from Cincinnati, OH to Cambridge City, IN. The last 8 miles was completed from Cambridge City to Hagerstown in 1847.

The Perfect Circle Company, which operated for 100 years in Hagerstown, was the undisputed world leader in the development and manufacture of piston rings. It also gave the world cruise control, which was introduced as Speedostat in the 1958 Chrysler.
